A Self Funding Community

As Kill is a self funding community, we rely entirely on our parishioners' generosity to fund our activities. How we contribute is up to each of us in terms of investing our time, skills and money. Each person's circumstances vary; some can give much, some a little.

Financially, you can contribute weekly, monthly or annually – it's up to you. If you already contribute and you wish to increase or otherwise change your giving, this can be done at any time. If you do not wish to join the scheme, your regular offering can be made each Sunday in the usual way, although regular giving allows us to financially plan with confidence.

Tax Relief

One of the significant benefits of joining the financial stewardship scheme is the availability of tax relief on contributions above a minimum level. This can mean for example that an annual contribution of €250 could result in a refund to the Parish of a further €174.

PAYE Payer

The church may be able to claim a refund directly.

Self Employed

You will be eligible to disclose your contribution as a tax deductible expense by using our charity number CHY 4622.

Registered Company

A similar procedure applies to your contributions as for self employed individuals.
